 are held and firmly bound unto the People of the State of Illinois in
 the penal sum of Five hundred dollars Current money of the
 United States for the payment of which well and truly to be made
 we bind ourselves, our heirs, Executors & Administrators jointly several
 and firmly by these presents - The Condition of the above obligation
 is such, that whereas the said People of the said State of Illinois
 did at the April Term A. D. 1862 give a bill of Indictment
 before the Grand Jury in and for said County of Effingham and
 State of Illinois against one Beacheam Rhodes for the crime of
 uttering counterfeit coin, and the Judge of said Court upon a
 writ for a continuance of the trial of the said Beacheam Rhodes
 assigned the said Beacheam Rhodes to give bond in the sum of
 Five hundred dollars for his appearance at the next Term of
 the Effingham County Circuit Court A. D. 1862

Now if the said Beacheam Rhodes
 shall be and appear at the next Term of said Court as aforesaid
 and there attend his said trial, as in case of his acquittal by
 due course of law - to be had at that time & place, or in case
 the said Beacheam Rhodes shall be and appear before said Court for
 trial as aforesaid and shall be discharged by due course of law
 then this obligation to be null and void, otherwise to remain
 in full force and effect
