with the felonious intent to defraud one John Draper, did pass and give in payment to him the said Draper, eighteen pieces of false and counterfeit ^{each and every of which is} coin, of the form, fashion, similitude and color, resembling and apparently intended to resemble and pass for certain of the Gold Coin of the United States of America known as the gold coin piece of the denomination of a two and half dollar piece of the value of two dollars and fifty cents each, and which said United States coin was then and is current in the said State of Illinois said County of Effingham - and the said Jurors upon their oaths ~~do~~ aforesaid do further aver that he the said Rhodes then and there well knew that said ~~is~~ false and counterfeit-pieces were false and counterfeited when he so passed and gave the same in payment to the said Draper

And the said Grand Jurors chosen selected and sworn as aforesaid in and for the County of Effingham aforesaid, in the name and by the authority of the People of the State of Illinois upon their oaths do further present that the said Rhodes on the day and year first aforesaid, with the felonious intent to defraud the said John Draper, three other pieces of false and counterfeit coin resembling and apparently intended to resemble and pass for certain of the Gold Coin of the United States of America known as the gold dollar piece, ^{then and} now current in the State of Illinois, he the said Rhodes then and there well knowing the said pieces of coin to be counterfeit when he so passed and gave the same in payment to the said Draper.

and so the jurors aforesaid upon their oaths aforesaid do say that he the said Rhodes ~~was~~ then and there was guilty of the crime of unlawfully passing said counterfeit coin in manner and form aforesaid

 to prejudice, damage and defraud the said Bank
 on the day and year aforesaid, he the said Rhodes
 then and there well knowing the said Bill to be
 false forged and counterfeited when he so
 uttered published and passed the same as
 aforesaid Contrary to the form of the Statute
