The People vs. Wm. C. Rhodes

Indictment for uttering counterfeit money

Wm. C. Rhodes) Def.

Now on this day comes the said People by their Attorney  
 Lyman H. Smith, State Attorney for term of the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, and  
 the said Wm. C. Rhodes in his own proper person, and the said Wm. C. Rhodes  
 being arraigned in due form of law enters his plea in open Court of  
 not guilty of said charge of uttering counterfeit money. Whereupon there came  
 the Jury to wit: Calvin Martin - Henry Turazy - Thomas Hamilton - William  
 Robertson - Henry Harmon - Henry Kempker - John C. Gamble - John A. Kroger  
 Edmund J. Oakley - John L. Baty - Christopher Mann & Levi Moore  
 who being duly sworn and sworn and after hearing the evidence presented  
 in said cause, return & consider of their verdict, and returned into Court  
 the following verdict, to wit: That the Jury find the defendant Wm. C. Rhodes  
 guilty of the charge of passing counterfeit money and sentence him to the Prison  
 for the term of one year, Oct. 21, 1862. Henry Kempker - John C. Gamble  
 Thomas Hamilton - Levi Moore - Edmund J. Oakley - R. C. Martin - William  
 Robertson - John A. Harmon - Henry Turazy - John L. Baty - John A. Kroger and  
 C. Mann

It is therefore ordered and considered by the Court that the said Brachon C. Rhodes be taken hence to the Penitentiary of the State of Illinois and be there confined for the space of One year - One day thereof shall be spent in solitary confinement and the remainder at hard labor and that he pay the costs of this proceeding hereof &c
