Ordered that Spencer Records, John Hinton, Simon Hinton, Jap Turner, Joshua Barnes, Peter Lee, and Lawrence Williams be Recommended to his Excellency the Governor as proper persons to be Commissionsed as Captains of the Militia of this County

Ordered that Ignatious Rofs, John Curtis, William Brooks, David Rankin, Thomas Lee, Abraham Seffoy and John Wood be Recommended as proper persons to be Commissionsed & appointed Lieutenants of the Militia of this County

Ordered that Dennis Murphy, William Chen with John Reins David Flora, Nathl. Hinkson, William Beckley and Michael Casady be Recommended as proper persons to be commissionsed as Ensigns of the Militia of this County

Simon Hinton, John Hinton and Joshua Barnes came into Court and took the Oaths of Allegiance of Captains of the Militia

John Reins, and David Flora as Ensigns of the Militia of this County took the Oaths of Office and Allegiance
