ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED IN THE SEVERAL COLUMNS AS FOLLOWS:  
Cols. 6, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, and 25-For all persons.  
Col. 24-For all persons 15 years of age and over.  
Cols. 26, 27, and 28-For heads of families only. (Col. 8 requires no entry for a farm family.)  
Col. 29-For married persons only.  
Col. 30-For all males 21 years of age and over.
